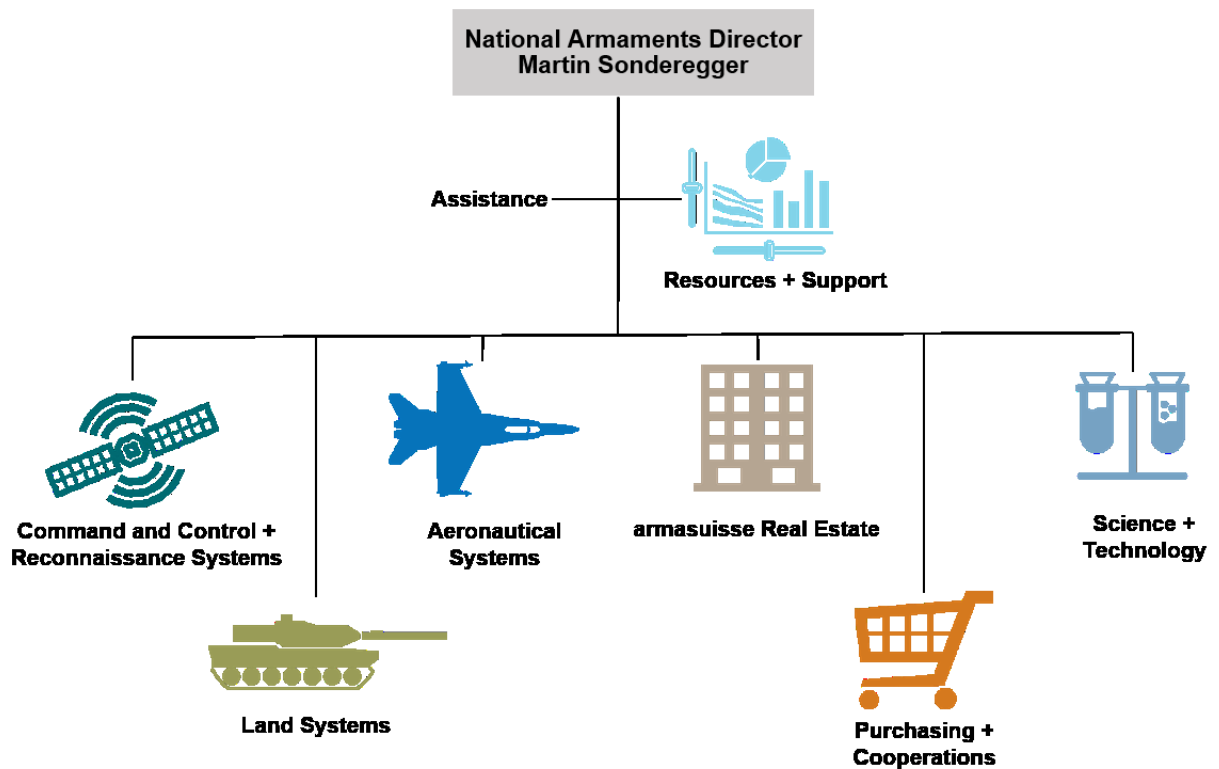
## Science + Technology

The Science and Technology competence sector S+T consists of the specialist departments of Sensor Technology, Communication and Electromagnetic Protection, Cyber Defence and Information, Test Centres, Research Management, Model Design and Simulation, Explosive Materials and Ammunition Monitoring. S+T tests and evaluates the operational capability, functionality and efficiency as well as the security requirements of current and future systems of the Swiss Armed Forces and other customers. S+T makes every effort to ensure that customers can make conscious technology decisions, minimise investment risks and are informed about future technologies.

## Real estate management

armasuisse Real Estate, the center of competence for real estate within the DDPS, is responsible for the overall management of 24,000 hectares of property and 7,000 objects for the Federal Department of Defence, Civil Protection and Sport DDPS. Within the wide-ranging portfolio armasuisse Real Estate is responsible for implementing and planning existing and future customer needs, the management of objects in military use, the realisation of new developments and reconstructions, and for the sale and liquidation of infrastructure which is no longer needed.
