Dr. Markus Höpflinger completed his master's degree in electrical engineering and information technology at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH) in Zurich. After his studies, he contributed to the development of the locomotion system for the Mars Rover «ExoMars» of the European Space Agency. He subsequently obtained a doctorate at the Autonomous Systems Laboratory (ASL) at ETH Zurich in the field of legged robots. Between 2013 and 2015, Mark Höpflinger was a leading researcher and was involved in various national and international research projects of the ASL. Since 2015, he has been working as a research programme director for armasuisse Science & Technology, the centre for technological foresight of the Swiss Federal Department of Defence, Civil Protection and Sport (DDPS). Since 2017, Markus Höpflinger has been Head of the Swiss Drone and Robotics Centre of the DDPS.
